General information

- The figures listed in pricelist refer to a unit of measure excluding installation.
- All the price figures have been stated **excluding VAT**.
- Prices shall be determined by the closest larger dimension (with respect to the table figure).
- Figures in tables are stated in millimetres, surface measures in m.
- Any orders shall list width as the first dimension figure, followed by the height figure.
- These products are provided with a **2-year** warranty. The warranty shall not apply to defects caused by failure to obey the installation instructions, improper **usage** or improper utilization of the product.
- Any orders submitted to the manufacturing plant shall be drafted using the order forms or via the company website. The company shall not handle any claims submitted in relevance to errors or mistakes incurred on orders in any other form.
- Delivery period 4 weeks, RAL design subject to agreement

Exterior blinds



Exterior blinds represent the most frequently used exterior screening features. They allow for continuous regulation of natural lighting, capture of direct sunradiation and help to protect from its harmful effects. These blinds are used not only to screen windows of modern family houses, but also in offices and commercial property. Any requirements for maximum obscuration can be served using the Z-PROFIL slat type, which provides for almost perfect effect. The electric control is more convenient for long-term usage, as such system ensures longer life and options to connect the unit to several different kinds of automatic controls (wind, sun, thermal and time controls). The delivery can be provided with top panels.







The Ext 50 series is manufactured in two types

- Exterior model includes a steel guide line.
- Interior model without a steel guide line.




In case of motor control, the upper profile is manufactured in the size of 58x56mm, thus the construction is prepared in the same way as with the C80, C65 blinds. Holders 1,2,3,4 are used during the installation. The blind is guided by a string, and anchored with a holder to the window frame or to the floor.










PREPARATION FOR WIRING

The preparation for wiring is done according to the customer's requests. It can be divided into four basic groups:

- Control by means of a local switch without additional demands on automatics or central switching.
- Control by means of a local switch in combination with central control or automatics.
- Intelligent control.
- Radio control by means of remote controllers.


Control by means of a local switch without additional demands on automatics or central switching:

- If this type of control is used, a junction box can be used during wiring preparation at the upper part of the window, where the cable can be led out to the external jalousie (CYKY 5Cx1,5 mm2). From the junction box, continue to the switch (CYKY 3A x1,5 mm2). In the external part, lead the cable of the approximate. length of 1.5 m through the bushing.
- If the 230V distribution is led through switch boxes, the jalousie outlet can be led out from the switch directly without using a junction box, by means of a cable (CYKY 5Cx1,5 mm2), observing the above criteria.



Control by means of a local switch in combination with central control or automatics:


- If the jalousie control design requires central control, it is most suitable to use a deep junction box (KU68 in the upper part of the window or in the soffit) and another one for the switch. In the given object, a place must be chosen from which to control all the jalousies with a central command. From that place, cable is led to the first junction box, and further looped as far as the last jalousie. Use a cable (CYKY 5Cx1,5 mm2) for the distribution, including the junction box – switch connection. Supply 230V voltage to the box in which the central controller is to be located with a cable (CYKY 3Cx1,5 mm2). If wind or solar automatics is used, the automatics outlet is to be terminated at the central switch with a conductor (3X0,8 mm2 of network distribution). In the external part, lead a cable out of the junction box through the bushing (CYKY 5Cx1,5 mm2), of the length of approx. 1.5 m.



PREPARATION FOR WIRING


Intelligent control:

- In the objects of such a type where the so-called intelligent control (actors combined with a PC) is used, the outlets of all jalousies must be led to the distribution box in which the control is located, by means of a cable (CYKY 5Cx1,5 mm2). Each jalousie is connected to an actor, the commands should be mutually blocked in the equipment (interconnected via a break contact) for the upward and downward direction to prevent damage of the drive.



Radio control by means of remote controllers:


- The radio control is the most comfortable. Various control elements can be chosen (central switching, automatics). All is set remotely through controllers of the types used. Installing the wiring, locate a junction box at every jalousie and only loop the 230V supply voltage, including the outlet in the external part to the jalousie. For the distribution, use a cable (CYKY 3Cx1,5 mm2); also, lead the above mentioned cable for the 230V supply to the place where the automatics outlet is to be located.





This solution does not require any further cables, (except for motor power supply), it also enables additional reprogramming of transmitters.


FRS transmitters are supplied as "wall mounted" switch units, portable single - or four-channels types.


A single-channel FRS transmitter controls a single shutter or a single set of shutters.
